## ***Indiana General Assembly 2024 Edition***

January 16, 2024

Good Morning,

The legislature returns today for the second week of the 2024 short session. The general assembly is already running at full throttle with floor calendars in the House and Senate, and nine committee hearings – with 29 total bills – on the calendar today.

Highlighting the floor calendars today are HB 1025 Mixed Beverages, the first bill on third reading this session, and HB 1002 Enforcement of Equal Educational Opportunity – a republican agenda item – which is on second reading.

In the House, Local Government will hear HB 1158 County Sheriffs. Public Health will consider five bills, including HB 1260 Indiana Department of Health and HB 1327 Health and Insurance Matters. Roads will take up three bills, including HB 1090 Transportation Matters. Government and Regulatory Reform will hear four bills, including HB 1026 Commission, Committee, and Board Administration. There are four bills in the Utilities committee, including HB 1277 State Administration of Federal BEAD Program.

In the Senate, Homeland Security will hear three bills, including SB 232 Statewide 911 System. Tax will take up three bills, including SB 20 Municipal Riverfront Development District Permits. Corrections has five bills, including SB 36 Interference With Boundary Marker and SB 149 Tobacco Sales.
