Good Morning,

It's the third week of the 2024 legislative session, and the half way point (Feb.5 & 6) is only two weeks away. Legislators will continue working bills through committees for the next week and a half while also spending significant time in session.

Today, the House has 26 bills on second reading and eight bills on third reading. Among the bills eligible for amendment on second reading are HB 1001 Education and Higher Education Matters, HB 1003 Administrative Law, HB 1133 Use of Digitally Altered Media in Elections, HB 1277 State Administration of Federal BEAD Program, HB 1383 Wetlands, and HB 1399 PFAS Chemicals.

Among the bills on third reading are HB 1004 Thirteenth Check and HB 1026 Commission, Committee, and Board Administration.

The Senate has 20 bills on second reading and eight bills on third reading. Among the bills eligible for amendment on second reading are SB 4 Fiscal and Administrative Matters, SB 148 Workforce Data Collection, SB 150 Artificial Intelligence and Cybersecurity, SB 205 Collaborative Brewing, and SB 297 Administrative Rules.

Among the bills on third reading is SB 36 Interference With Boundary Marker.

In committee, House Agriculture will hear four bills, including HB 1315 Biofuel Tax Credits and HB 1337 Preemption of HOA Regulation of Beekeeping. Veterans Affairs will hear four bills, including HB 1194 State Administration.

Senate Agriculture will hear SB 104 Veterinary Medicine and Elections will hear SB 135 Redistricting Deadline.
